Yes. Electoral Literacy initiatives have been taken up by the college through NSS Department. The Principal is the Chairperson of the club with NSS Programme Officer as the faculty Coordinator. 02 students are also appointed as student coordinator. The primary objective of the club is sensitizing the student community about democratic rights which includes casting votes in elections.

Yes. The ELC has both faculty coordinator and student coordinators, appointed by the Head of the Institution. The ELC is functional. The college has undertaken following initiatives.

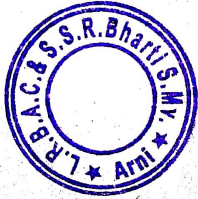
- Constitution and Voter's Day is conducted by the college to improve electoral literacy.
