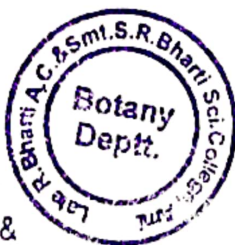

## **Study Tour Report**

**Organized by:** Department of Botany

**College:** Late Rajkamalgi Bharti Arts, Commerce, and Smt. S. R. Bharti Science College, Arni

**Tour Location:** Melghat Wildlife Sanctuary, Chikhaldara, Dist. Amravati

**Date:** 22nd September 2024

**Introduction** The Department of Botany organized a one-day educational study tour to Melghat Wildlife Sanctuary, Chikhaldara, on 22nd September 2024. The tour was planned as a part of the curriculum to provide students with practical exposure to the rich biodiversity and ecological importance of plant species. The sanctuary, known for its unique flora and fauna, served as an excellent location for learning about medicinal plants and their uses.

### **Objectives**

1. To observe and study the various plant species present in their natural habitat.
2. To understand the ecological and medicinal importance of plants.
3. To enhance practical knowledge of botany beyond classroom learning.
4. To inculcate conservation awareness among students.

**Participants** The tour involved 19 students from the B.Sc. II Year, Department of Botany, along with the following faculty members:

- **Dr. U. A. More**

### **Itinerary**

- **Departure:** The group departed early in the morning from the college premises.
- **Arrival at Melghat Wildlife Sanctuary:** The group reached the sanctuary by mid-morning and was briefed by the teachers about the objectives of the tour.
- **Visit to Various Locations:** The group explored different spots in Chikhaldara, guided by the faculty members.
- **Lunch Break:** A lunch break was taken in the serene environment of the sanctuary.
- **Observations and Discussions:** The students documented plant species and engaged in discussions about their medicinal properties.
- **Return Journey:** The group departed from the sanctuary in the evening and returned to the college safely.

**Observations** During the tour, the students observed a variety of plant species, including medicinally significant ones, under the expert guidance of the faculty. Some notable species studied included:

1. *Terminalia arjuna* (Arjuna) - Known for its cardiovascular benefits.
2. *Withania somnifera* (Ashwagandha) - Renowned for its adaptogenic and stress-relieving properties.
3. *Tinospora cordifolia* (Guduchi) - Known for its immune-boosting properties.
4. *Aegle marmelos* (Bael) - Valued for its digestive and anti-inflammatory benefits.
5. *Curcuma longa* (Turmeric) - Recognized for its anti-inflammatory and antioxidant properties.
6. *Ocimum sanctum* (Tulsi) - Revered for its antimicrobial and stress-relieving properties.
7. *Azadirachta indica* (Neem) - Known for its antibacterial and antifungal benefits.
8. *Phyllanthus emblica* (Amla) - Valued for its high vitamin C content and antioxidant properties.
9. *Bacopa monnieri* (Brahmi) - Known for its cognitive-enhancing effects.
10. *Adhatoda vasica* (Vasaka) - Renowned for its respiratory benefits and cough relief.

The students also gained insights into the ecological roles of plants in the sanctuary's ecosystem and their importance in sustaining wildlife.

### Learning Outcomes

1. Enhanced understanding of plant taxonomy and medicinal properties.
2. Awareness of the need for conservation of regional plant species.
3. Improved practical knowledge of ecological relationships and biodiversity.
4. Exposure to real-world applications of botany in ethnomedicine.

**Conclusion** The study tour to Melghat Wildlife Sanctuary was an enriching and educational experience. It provided students with a unique opportunity to connect theoretical knowledge with practical applications. The guidance and expertise of the faculty members, especially Dr. M. R. Kakpure, Dr. U. A.
